

Homecoming Committee Application Rules

- Closed door meeting; only registered committee members and selected faculty, staff, and students of the homecoming selection committee
- The applications will be “blank” applications; no one will know the name on the application except for the VP of Student Affairs of SGA
- If any member of the committee knows who an applicant is by their activities will remove themselves from the room; this will be documented on the back of the application
 - VP of Student Affairs of SGA will not vote on any of the applicants
 - Everyone will have the same scoring rubric for each participant
- The scoring sheets will be averaged for a “final score”; this score will be used against the other applicants with the highest score winning
- A total of sixteen (16) interviews will be given out to applicants based on the quality of the applications, number of applications and past number given out; (2008 was 7 males and 7 females receiving interviews)
- All scoring will be independent; No consulting between each judge; they will fill out their scoring rubric and turn it in
- ALL CONTENTS OF APPLICATIONS ARE CONFIDENTIAL AND WILL NOT LEAVE THE CONFINES OF THE MEETING ROOM
