

Homecoming King and Queen Rules

In order to qualify as an applicant for King/Queen, you must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Be full time student at SRU (Grad or Undergrad)
- ✓ Have a minimum QPA of 2.75
- ✓ Undergrad Students -- Have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours at SRU
- ✓ Graduate Students – Have completed a minimum of 9 credit hours at SRU
- ✓ Be nominated by a registered organization/residence hall on campus OR submit a petition with signatures of 50 enrolled SRU students
- ✓ Organizations/Residence Halls are allowed to submit ONE application per gender
- ✓ Past Homecoming court members ARE permitted to run
- ✓ Homecoming committee members ARE permitted to run, not recommended due to conflict of interest

Applicants will be expected to:

- Complete an essay describing “How Attending Slippery Rock has changed you as a Person.” Experience and examples are expected to be included. Essays may NOT exceed two pages and also must be double spaced. Resumes and all other supplements attached to the application will not be considered, or accepted.

The Following SRU Students will not be permitted to run:

- Past Homecoming King and Queen at SRU
- Homecoming chairpersons for both SGA and UPB

There will be an application fee of \$10.00 which will be returned if you are not selected as member of the 2009 Homecoming Court.

The essay and application will be used as a screening process to determine which applicants are to be interviewed. A panel of five judges will then interview each applicant. The panel consists of judges from a variety of campus disciplines. Interviews will be held on **September 22nd** and will be based on the three categories below. The panel will choose the homecoming court. The homecoming King and Queen will be determined by popular vote.

- A. Presentation
 - a. Sincerity
 - b. Articulation
 - c. Professionalism
- B. Involvement
 - a. Number of Activities
 - b. Leadership Positions
 - c. Accomplishments
- C. Essay
